

Model Statement in case of liquidated succession

A) Sworn statement of discharged liquidator :

I, _____, liquidator of the succession of _____, having been discharged of my functions following acceptance of the final account, declare that I have obtained from each heir of _____ the mandate to act, in the prescribed form. I join copy of these mandates to my statement.

Despite having been discharged of my functions as liquidator, I accept to act as a Representative and administrator (in the sense of sections 1299 and following of the *Civil Code of Quebec*) for and in the name of the succession for the purposes of making a Claim in relation to the court case *Spieser c Attorney General of Canada et al*, receiving payments, making account and proceeding with the division and/or remittance of amounts to heirs in the same proportions as those used to liquidate the succession of _____.
